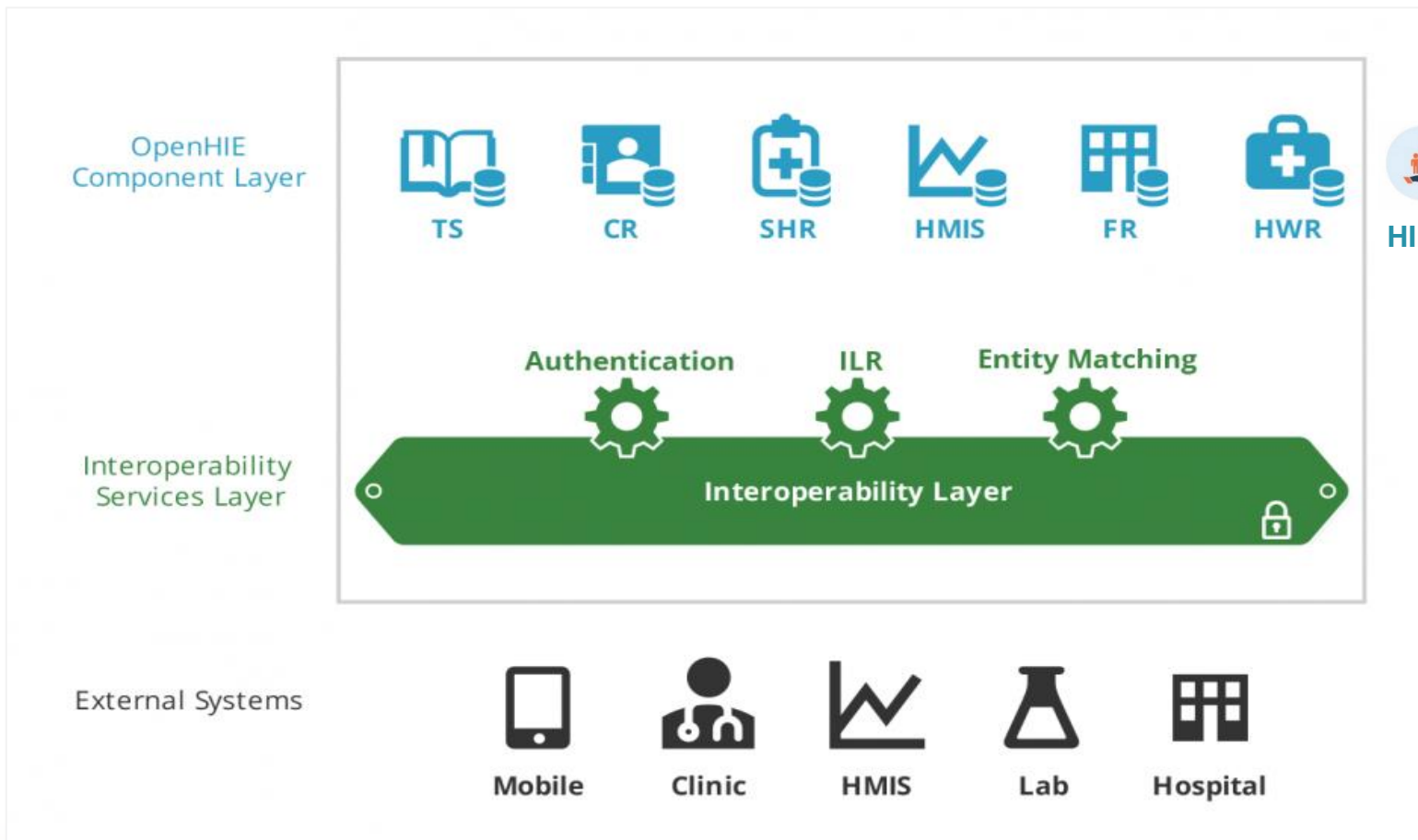

Tool to manage social health insurance



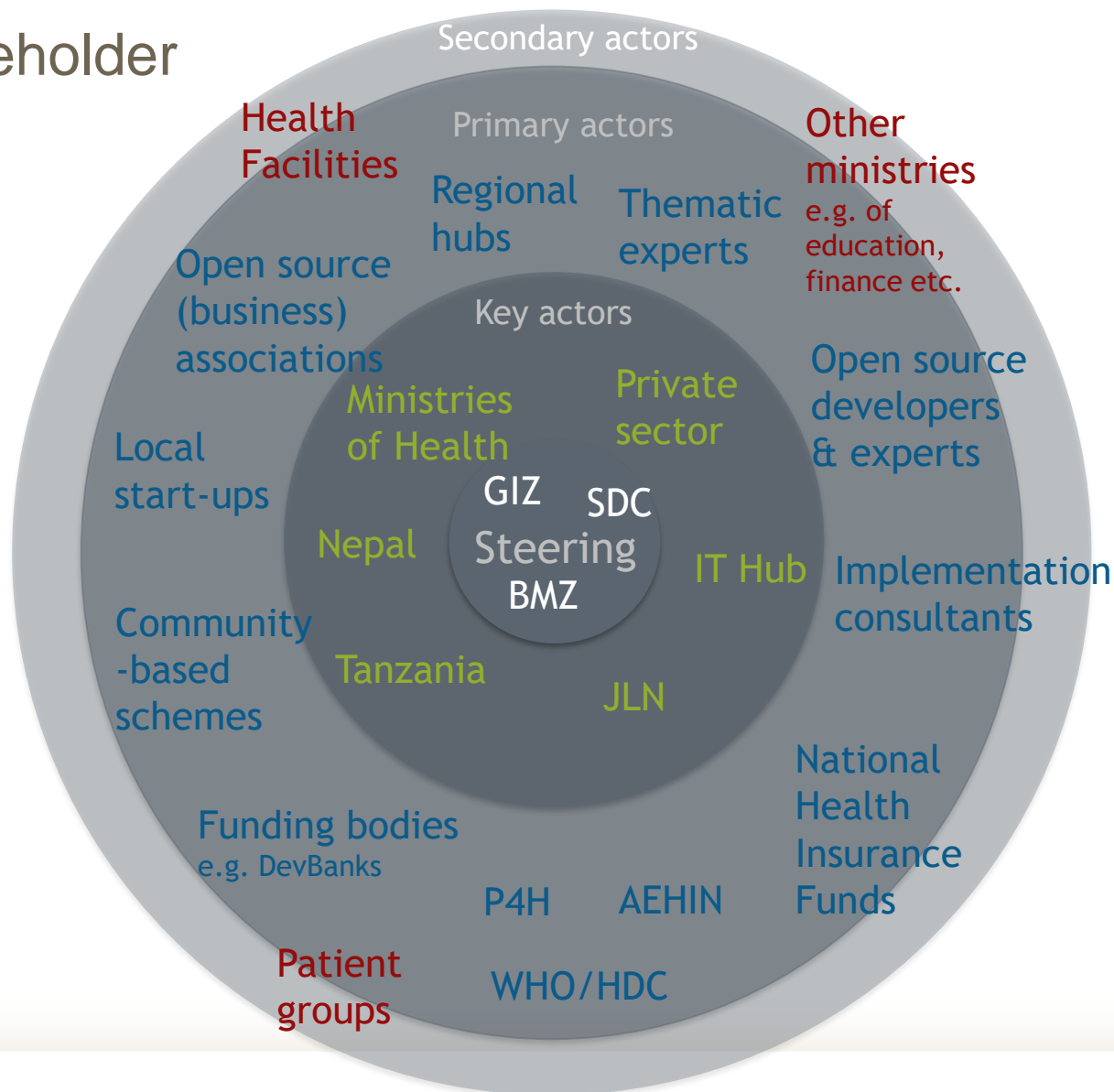
- Covers core business processes: Beneficiary Management, Management, Policy Management, Claim Management, Payments and Facilities
- Started in 2011, developed by SwissTropical and Public Health Institute (Swiss TPH)
- Customized in Nepal (**national**), Tanzania (**community-based**), Cameroon (**church-based**)
